Item: **Ordinance Amendment Addressing Micromobility**

SUMMARY OF REQUESTED ACTION:

City staff is bringing forward a micromobility ordinance to address motorized foot scooters, update the existing bicycle language, and add considerations for Shared Transportation Systems in City Code 61.53. The components of the draft ordinance following this cover sheet were reviewed by City Council at a pre-Council meeting on July 19, 2021. Following Council considerations, the following changes were made:

- 1) Increase the allowed fleet size to 100 shared devices (61.53(d)(7)(ii))
- 2) Eliminate the helmet requirement for users of micromobility devices over the age of 16 (61.53)(b)(1)

As part of the changed addressing Shared Transportation Systems, ordinance language to amend Chapter 51 – Licenses and Permits and Service Charges of the City is included for the introduction of the \$500 annual license fee for Shared Transportation Systems.

Should the Council wish to proceed with the language as shown in the attached draft ordinance, a motion to introduce the ordinance would be in order.
