

ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING WINONA CITY CODE,
CHAPTER 61 – TRAFFIC, SCHEDULES A AND B

THE CITY OF WINONA DOES ORDAIN (new material is underlined; deleted material is lined out; sections which are not proposed to be amended are omitted; sections which are only proposed to be re-numbered are only set forth below as to their number and title):

SECTION 1. That Schedule A of Winona City Code, Chapter 61 – Traffic, Section 61.26 (f), Handicapped Parking Areas, be amended as follows:

HANDICAPPED PARKING ZONES

The following portions of streets and lots are hereby designated as handicapped parking areas when identified by the posting of signs incorporating the international symbol of access in white on blue and indicating that the parking space is reserved for the handicapped with vehicle displaying the required certificate, license plates, or insignia:

Third Street, southerly side, from 254 feet west of the west line of Johnson Street to 23 feet westerly, thereof.

Fourth Street, northerly side, from 20 feet east of the east line of Washington Street to 20 feet easterly, thereof.

SECTION 2. That Schedule B of Winona City Code, Chapter 61 – Traffic, Section 61.26 (e), Limited Parking Zones, be amended as follows:

TWO-HOUR PARKING

No person shall stop, park or leave standing any vehicle, either attended or unattended, for a period longer than 120 minutes between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. of each and every day except Sundays and legal holidays, on the following streets, alleys, and lots in the city, and any vehicle which is moved and reparked in the same block, alley or lot during such 120 minute period shall be deemed to have remained stationary:

Fourth Street, northerly side, from a point ~~40~~ 20 feet east of the east line of Washington Street to a point 20 feet west of the west line of Johnson Street.

Third Street, southerly side, from a point 20 feet east of the east line of Huff Street to the west line of Winona Street, from a point 40 feet

east of the east line of Winona Street to a point 168 feet west of the west line of Johnson Street, and from a point 76 feet west of the west line of Johnson Street to a point 30 feet west of the west line of Johnson Street.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication.
